

Lithuanian Amateur Open Championship 2022 (Men & Ladies)

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

Organizers

Lithuanian Golf Federation (LGF) European Center Golf Club

Date

Practice day: 18th August 1st round: 19th August 2nd round: 20th August 3rd (final) round: 21st August

Form of play

Individual: Stroke play over 3 rounds of 18 holes each day.

Eligibility of competitors

- All competitors must be:
- a) amateur golfers.
- b) golfers whose exact active handicap does not exceed:
 - men: 28.5*
 - ladies: 35.9*

The handicap must be certified by the secretary of the national golf authority or entrant's home club and must have been valid on the date of entry.

* Players can register to the championship with a higher handicap as well. Waiting list will be created for them. Participants from the waiting list will be added to championship if participants with appropriate handicap won't exceed entries limit. Players from the waiting list will be informed about possibility to participate in the championship not earlier than 14th of August.

Number of Competitors

144 competitors (120 men and 24 ladies) shall be eligible to compete. The number of ladies will not exceed 24, then additional men's entries will be added. If the number of entries exceeds 144, places in the starting field will be decided by lower handicap. Unsuccessful entrants shall be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur.

Cut

The 72 lowest scores (60 men and 12 ladies) after 36 holes including ties shall qualify for the 3rd (final) round of Individual play.

The Committee is authorised to alter the cut in the event of a smaller entry.

Decision of ties

In the event of a tie for first place after three rounds, the winner shall be decided by a playoff by stroke play over 18th hole.

In case of a tie for the silver or bronze medal, the places will be decided on the basis of scores recorded for the final 36, 18, 9, 6, 3 holes or last hole, in that order. If a tie still exists, an 18-hole count-back will be used on the first round as well.

Start

Flights consisting of 3-4 players will be starting every 10 minutes from holes No. 1 and No. 10 starting from 8:00. *Championship committee can modify start list if number of players is lower than determined. Participants must be informed about modification as soon as possible.*

Starting tees

Men – starting from white* tees. Ladies – starting from yellow* tees. *Championship committee can modify starting tee difficulty on chosen holes.

Registration closing date

16th of August, 2022, 12:00

Entries will only be accepted with the official entry form filled in and full entrance fee paid before the closing date.

Entry fee

- 150 EUR.
- 100 EUR for ECGK members
- 75 EUR for the Lithuanian National Team
- 75 EUR for U18: players who were up to 17 years old on 01.01.2022.
